Preschool Aboriginal Cultural Incursion with Koori Kinnections

Educators from Koori Kinnections will come and share their knowledge with us. This might include traditional games, bushfood, art, craft, dance and learning about traditional resources.

Police Visit

We will be encouraging children to dress up as a character from their favourite story, and/or bring in their favourite story to share with their class.

Grandparents and Visitors Day

We would love to welcome you, the family, grandparents and/or special visitors to come and spend time with us at preschool from 9:30am-11:30am.

Please bring something for morning tea that can be shared with other families. We ask that it contains no nuts and has a list of ingredients used.

On the day you are welcome to play with your child, engage with other families and have morning tea. We will also have a small concert in which children will perform some of their favourite songs (we may even ask you to join in with us).

Show and Tell

Please remember children are welcome to bring in something to share for show and tell. Children are encouraged to bring a photo, favourite storybook, their experience at their kindergarten orientation or game in to share for show and tell. No toys will be shown during show and tell time.

Spare clothes

Children require spare clothes even though they are toilet trained. While learning at preschool, children can experience messy or wet play and will need to change their clothes. Please make sure the spare clothes (including socks and undies) are appropriate for the current weather season.

Sun Safety

Now that the UV is 3 and above, sun safety measures need to be taken. Children will now be required to wear a hat and apply sunscreen while playing outside.

Transition to school statements

It is a requirement for us to complete a Transition to School Statement for any child attending a government school the following year. These statements highlight the children's learning, development and wellbeing and will be given to the school. We are asking everyone to sign the consent form, even if your child is going to a Catholic/Independent School, or returning to St Dunstan's as we will complete the same form for all children and will give you a copy.
